#### Who We Are

#### **Compliance Inspection Group**

- 6 Environmental Compliance Inspectors (ECIs)
- 2 Laboratory/Field Technicians
- 1 Senior Environmental Inspector
- All ECIs conduct wastewater and stormwater inspections at a variety of businesses, such as:
  - Significant Industrial Users
  - Automotives
  - Restaurants
  - Dentals
  - Machine Shops
  - \* Etc.

### Sunnyvale's Program

- 100% of C3s in our inventory inspected annually
  - Currently 150 Sites
  - ◆ 165 inspections FY 18/19
  - FY 18/19 = 96% Compliance Rate
- Completed in rainy season- October-April
- Of the 150 sites
  - 109 are residential
  - 41 commercial
  - \* 39 are vault based
    - Now accepting third party certifications



  - Access City's Building and Planning Modules to check on completion
  - Assigned to Inspectors in Workplan
- Inspector Stewardship

### Challenges

- Home Owner Associations (HOA)
  - Figuring out the contacts
  - \* Some can be slow to act due to committee
- No HOA
  - Dealing with individual home owners
- Staff Lack of Plant Knowledge/Ground Cover
- Structural Errors/Deficiencies
  - Increase communications with installation inspectors
